

Break points between items of a column-direction flex line

The second card below declares `break-before: page`. A column-direction line's items are stacked in the block axis, so this is a real break point between two items of the same line - it now moves that item (and anything after it in the line) onto the next page instead of being read only from the container's very first child.

Item 1 — stays on this page
