

CSS font-palette

A COLR/CPAL color font can ship several palettes; `font-palette` chooses between them, and `@font-palette-values` defines custom palettes (a `base-palette` plus per-index `override-colors`). The hero below is a subset of Nabla, a real COLR v1 font with 7 palettes, shown in its default palette.

Palette selection

The same text, same font — only `font-palette` differs:

`font-palette: normal (palette 0)`

`@font-palette-values --blue { base-palette: 2 }`

`font-palette: light (light-flagged palette)`

`font-palette: dark (dark-flagged palette)`
