leader() distributes the line's remaining width across every leader on it, including a later sibling element's content it never itself declared - here the fill and the page number are two separate <a> elements, not one.

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CROSS- REFERENCES (TARGET- TEXT() MODES)

target-text(<target>[, content | before | after | first-letter]) pulls text from another element without retyping it: the default content mode copies the target's own text, before/after copy that element's generated ::before/::after content, and first-letter copies just its opening character. Chapter One's heading carries a generated "(revised)" suffix via ::after and Chapter Three's carries a "Featured:" badge via ::before - both pulled here purely through target-text(), not duplicated by hand.
